**ORDER**

This matter coming to be heard on Plaintiffs' second motion to continue contempt proceedings and for other relief, the Court hereby ORDERS:

(1) Plaintiffs' motion is granted. A hearing will be held on March 20, 2009 at 10:00 a.m./p.m., at which time Defendants are ordered to Show Cause why they should not be held in contempt of the September 5, 2008 contempt order and the May 23, 2008 protective order. The Court orders individual Defendants Manuel Morales, Enrique Gonzalez, and any Spanish-speaking SFSI manager who communicated with Mr. Morales on November 12, 2008 to be in attendance.

(2) Prior to the hearing, Defendants' shall produce to Plaintiffs records of all calls sent and received from any cellular telephone used by Manuel Morales, Hector Santillan, Enrique Gonzalez, and any other Spanish-speaking SFSI manager, as well as records for all phone numbers associated with the SFSI offices in Tilly and Russelville, Arkansas, for the month of November, 2008;


(3) By no later than March 9, 2009, ~~December 9, 2008~~, Defendants shall pay the fees and costs

billed to them on September 25, 2008, in the amount of \$46,311.66, that were incurred in pursuing Plaintiffs' successful contempt petition, as set forth in Court's September 5, 2003 order.

(4) Within ten days of receiving a bill from Plaintiffs, Defendants are ordered to pay them their reasonable attorney's fees and costs incurred in pursuing this second reopening of the contempt proceedings.

It is so ORDERED.
