



ORDER

Before the court is Plaintiffs’ Application for Temporary Restraining Order, filed January 9, 2007. In a state case styled *Guillermo Ramos v. The City of Farmers Branch, et al.*, pending in the 116th Judicial District Court in Dallas County, the court has issued an Order Granting Temporary Restraining Order enjoining the City of Farmers Branch and its officials from effectuating or enforcing the ordinance that is the subject of the lawsuit before this court. As the state court has temporarily enjoined the City of Farmers Branch and its officials from enforcing the ordinance, any action by this court at this stage would be superfluous insofar as ruling on the pending motion. Plaintiffs’ application is therefore temporarily **denied as moot**. The court will take no further action on the application at this time, except to issue the following briefing schedule: the City of Farmers Branch shall file their response to Plaintiffs’ application **by January 18, 2007**, and Plaintiffs shall file their reply by **January 22, 2007**.
