

ORDER

On this day, the Court considered Respondents' "Motion To Dismiss As Moot," filed in the above-captioned cause on May 11, 2006. Therein, Respondents pray the Court dismiss Petitioner Ali M. Abdulle's "Petition For A Writ Of Habeas Corpus Pursuant To 28 U.S.C. § 2241" because Respondents released Petitioner from custody on an order of supervision on May 2, 2006.<sup>1</sup> On May 16, 2006, Petitioner filed a Response, through which Petitioner expresses no opposition to Respondents' request that the Petition be dismissed. Nonetheless, Petitioner submits that he should not be required to pay costs, as reflected in Respondents' proposed order. After due consideration, the Court is of the opinion that, as a result of Petitioner's release, his Petition is now moot, and should be dismissed without costs.

Accordingly, **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that Respondents' "Motion To Dismiss As Moot" is **GRANTED**.


