16 The following minute order is made at the direction of the Court, the Honorable
17 James P. Donohue, United States Magistrate Judge:

18 Petitioner's response to the Government's motion to dismiss, which is due Friday,
19 March 3, 2017, at 5:00 p.m., shall include a discussion of the following:

20 (1) In the amended habeas petition and complaint for declaratory and injunctive
21 relief, petitioner alleges violations of the Fifth Amendment's procedural and substantive due
22 process clauses, the Fourth Amendment's prohibition against unlawful seizure, and the Fifth
23 Amendment's equal protection clause. Dkt. 41 at 22-41. As relief, he primarily seeks
24 immediate release, declaratory judgment, and an injunction prohibiting the Government from
25 re-arresting or detaining him on the basis of the conduct described in the petition. Dkt. 41 at
26 27.
