**ORDER REQUIRING PUBLICATION
OF THE REPORT OF THE TASK FORCE**

Under the Consent Decree agreed to by parties to this action, the County Defendants

were required to create a Task Force that “shall diligently investigate and explore alternative methods for reducing the Jail population.” Based on the testimony during the Court’s hearing last month in Decatur, Alabama, it appears that insofar as the Task Force is concerned the County Defendants have failed to comply with the requirements of the Consent Decree.

Therefore, the County Defendants are hereby ORDERED to file with the Court a complete and full accounting of all meetings, deliberations and recommendations of the Task Force within thirty (30) days of the entry of this Order. This accounting shall include a complete listing of the Task Force members, with appropriate identifying information, and meetings, with applicable attendance records. To the extent that any of the other parties to this action may be able to illuminate the work of the Task Force, they are encouraged to do so.
