RULING

The court has received and reviewed defendant's Request for Restoration of Privileged Visitation Schedule or in the alternative Request for Emergency Injunctive Relief filed on November 13, 2007. The request in essence seeks a declaratory judgment and/or injunctive relief on behalf of all in-custody defendants related to a policy of the Maricopa County Sheriff's Office. The request, however, was filed in one criminal case. In addition, the request is based on potential future harm and fails to state a claim related to this defendant. Defense counsel does not contend that he was unable to confer with the defendant or suffered any hardship as a result of the inability to meet with his client during the new visitation hours. Therefore,

IT IS ORDERED denying the defendant's Request for Restoration of Privileged Visitation Schedule or in the alternative Request for Emergency Injunctive Relief without prejudice.
