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1 IT IS HEREBY STIPULATED AND AGREED TO, by and between the
2 Parties, through their respective counsel of record, that the following Stipulation
3 be entered:

4 1. Defendants shall send to Plaintiffs answers to the questions within
5 one business day of the Court's entry of the proposed order pursuant to this
6 Stipulation;

7 2. The answers to the questions shall not be disseminated to anyone
8 other than Plaintiffs' counsel and their experts or consultants and before
9 information contained in the answers to the questions is disseminated to
10 Plaintiffs' experts or consultants, such individuals must agree, in writing, to be
11 bound by this Stipulation and the corresponding Order;

12 3. In the event Plaintiffs believe the answers to the questions are
13 relevant to any motion in this action, the answers (or the information contained
14 therein) must be filed under seal. Nothing herein is or should be construed as a
15 waiver of any objection or arguments as to the relevancy (or lack thereof) of the
16 subject answers or questions.

17 4. In the event there is a claimed violation of the Court's Order pursuant to
18 this Stipulation, at the Defendants' request, the District Court shall promptly
19 conduct contempt proceedings against the person, persons and/or entity claimed
20 to have violated the Order pursuant to this Stipulation, which may include,
21 without limitation, any and all powers authorized by law to punish the contempt
22 including, without limitation, a finding of contempt, monetary sanctions (against
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1 Plaintiffs, their counsel, and/or third-parties) to punish past violations and to
2 discourage future violations, disqualification of counsel, evidentiary sanctions,
3 terminating sanctions, attorneys' fees, costs, and any other appropriate relief.

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
