The Court's Final Order of June 28, 2011, is amended as follows::

At page 16, line 17, the word "cable" shall be changed to "table";

At page 13, line 5, the reference to "Mod K" shall be changed to "Mod L";

At page 10, line 23; page 12, line 28; and page 14, line 5: the phrase "lower phones" shall be changed to "lower one phone";

At page 14, lines 8-9, the reference to "Isolation Cell 3" shall be changed to "Isolation Cell 1";

At page 2, line 3, the phrase "in the first year the monitor shall make four annual inspections" shall be changed to "in the first year, the monitor shall make four inspections"; and

With regard to lowering phones inside certain jail facilities, the circuitry and composition of the walls prevents that from occurring. GTEL has provided, and the County has installed, modified face plates which place operable buttons toward the bottom of the phone. The result brings the phones into compliance with the ADA's "highest operable part" maximum as either "front reach" or "side reach" phones, per ADA sections 4.31.3 and 4.2.5.
