Attorney John Hagar presented argument and proposed that the Court issue an order releasing inmates once capacity exceeds 361 due to the increased danger and risk of to the inmates and staff. Other housing alternatives are still being researched and will continue to be explored. Attorney John Hager addressed the court and proposed establishing a County Task Force (Interoffice Task Force) Kyle Sand concurred with proposal of Attorney John Hager re capacity order and establishing a task force. Court notes having toured the jail this afternoon. Court notes that he would be willing to participate in the task force. Court acknowledges that the conditions at the jail are intolerable, however does not find basis to go below figure of 361 and there is an exception. Court authorized Sheriff forthwith to release at his discretion inmates when the jail capacity has gone above 361. Sheriff directed to use same criteria of cap order signed by previous judges. Attorney Kyle Sands to draft order and confer with Attorney John Hagar prior to submitting it to the court for signature. Order effective immediately . (LV)
