ORDER

Defendants' Second Motion [135] for Enlargement of Time, filed December 22, 2004, is granted, nunc pro tunc and the time for defendants to respond to plaintiffs' motion for partial summary judgment on liability is extended to January 21, 2005.

Defendants have sought no further enlargement of time, nor did they respond to plaintiffs' status report [141] filed September 28, 2005, noting that mediation had concluded unsuccessfully and that the pending motions were ripe.

Accordingly, upon consideration of plaintiffs' unopposed motion [132] for partial summary judgment on liability, against defendant District of Columbia, it is this 8th day of November, 2005

ORDERED that plaintiffs' motion is granted. Plaintiffs Shannon Battle, Bernard Brown, Eugene Scott, Vonsauli Smith, and Timothy Williams are granted summary judgment establishing defendant District of Columbia's liability to each plaintiff for compensatory damages on each claim stated in plaintiffs' complaint.

A status conference shall be held on November 16, 2005 at 9:30 a.m. to set dates for pretrial and trial.
