ORDER

Before the Court is the United States’ Motion for an Order to Hold Defendants in Civil Contempt for Violation of This Court’s Remedial Order and to Stay Termination of the Remedial Order. (Doc. 97). At Paragraph 8 of the Motion, the United States requests that “[p]ending resolution of this motion, the United States moves this Court to stay the termination of the Remedial Order.” (*Id.* at 3 ¶ 8). Upon consideration of the United States’ request, the Court finds it appropriate to stay termination of the Remedial Order pending resolution of the substantive civil contempt motion.

Accordingly, the United States’ request for a stay found at Paragraph 8 of its Motion for an Order to Hold Defendants in Civil Contempt for Violation of This Court’s Remedial Order and to Stay Termination of the Remedial Order (Doc. 97 at 3 ¶ 8) is **GRANTED**. It is hereby **ORDERED** that termination of the Court’s Remedial Order of December 21, 2007 is **STAYED** pending resolution of the substantive civil contempt motion found in the United States’ Motion for an Order to Hold Defendants in Civil Contempt for Violation of This Court’s Remedial Order and to Stay Termination of the Remedial Order (Doc. 97). Pursuant to the Local Rules of this Court, Defendants shall file their Response to the United States’ civil contempt motion by

Thursday, December 30, 2010, unless extended by the Court or the Clerk of Court upon a timely request made according to the Local Rules.
