ORDER

The Court having requested the appearance of Dr. Robert B. Greifinger as an expert witness at the show cause hearing scheduled for July 8, 2004; and Dr. Greifinger having traveled to Atlanta on July 7, 2004, in anticipation of the hearing; and the show cause hearing having been cancelled pursuant to the Consent Order entered on July 7, 2004, providing for appointment of a receiver to replace Sheriff Barrett as custodian of the Fulton County Jail; and the parties having expressed no objection at the conference held on July 7, 2004, to the Court's appointment of Dr. Greifinger to continue his

inspections of the Fulton County Jail; now, therefore, pursuant to Fed. R. Evid. 706, it is hereby ORDERED that:

(1) Dr. Greifinger is appointed to serve as an expert witness in this case;

(2) Dr. Greifinger shall perform bimonthly inspections of the Fulton County Jail and shall issue written reports to the Court, the parties, and the receiver regarding conditions at the jail;

(3) Dr. Greifinger shall also be available to consult with the receiver regarding conditions at the jail;

(4) With notice to the parties, the Court may assign such further duties to Dr. Greifinger as it deems appropriate;

(5) Fulton County shall compensate Dr. Greifinger for his time at his usual hourly rate and shall reimburse Dr. Greifinger for all reasonable expenses incurred in connection with this appointment; and

(6) This appointment is retroactive to July 7, 2004, and shall remain in effect until December 31, 2004.

IT IS SO ORDERED, this 12 day of July, 2004.
