
**AGREED ORDER**

This case coming before the Court as a set matter, counsel for the parties having advised the Court of a proposed settlement that will be presented to the Cook County Board of Commissioners, and the Court, after a review of the terms and provisions of the proposed settlement, having concluded that the proposed settlement is reasonable,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

- 1) The proposed settlement is preliminarily approved and, if accepted by the Cook County Board of Commissioner, should be the subject of a fairness hearing pursuant to Rule 23(e)(C) of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure, with notice to be provided to each class member by first class mail, postage prepaid, to his last known address.
- 2) The terms of the proposed settlement shall remain confidential until presented to the Cook County Board of Commissioners.
- 3) Defendant County of Cook shall issue a check for one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000.00) payable to Kenneth N. Flaxman, an attorney for the plaintiff class, to cover the initial costs of notice. Mr. Flaxman shall maintain these funds in his sequestered client fund IOLTA account within the State of Illinois, and shall provide an appropriate accounting to defendants for these funds, which he may use solely and exclusively for providing notice of the proposed settlement of this action.
