On its own motion, the Court hereby ORDERS that the Order entered in this matter on May 24, 2007 (Rec. No. 143) dismissing this action as settled is SET ASIDE. The Court further hereby ORDERS as follows:

- 1) There being no objections filed to the Report and Recommendation entered in this matter on March 26, 2007 and the Court being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Report and Recommendation (Rec. No. 132) is ADOPTED as the Opinion of the Court and the claims of the Plaintiff Jillian Baker are DISMISSED with prejudice for failure to prosecute;
- 2) The Court, by Memorandum Opinion entered in this matter on March 26, 2007 (Rec. No. 130), having ordered the Plaintiffs Jennifer Reneer, Sara Hodgkin, Teresa Hendren, Derek Harvey, Kimberlie Simmons and Timothy Green to show cause why their claims should not be dismissed as sanctions under Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 37 and for failure to prosecute and those Plaintiffs having failed to respond, the claims of those Plaintiffs are DISMISSED with prejudice as sanctions under Rule 37 and for failure to prosecute; and

3) the claims of the Plaintiffs Maureen O. Mitchell, Deidra Wash, Rebecca Hagan, Karen Gamble, Penny Tillet, Sandra McCleave, Angela Lear, Jimmy Hammonds, Davanika Barker, Natasha Marie Hunter, Jonathan Cox, and Tommy Cummins having been previously DISMISSED by the Court pursuant to Orders dated August 16, 2005 (Rec. No. 35) and September 28, 2006 (Rec. No. 72), the claims of those Plaintiffs are and remain DISMISSED for the reasons stated in the August 16, 2005 Opinion and Order and the September 28, 2006 Opinion and Order.
