STIPULATION

In connection with the Consent Decree agreed to by the parties  
on ~~December 22~~ <sup>November</sup>, 1993 in the above captioned case, it is  
stipulated by counsel for the various State defendants as follows:

1. The Sanitary Code of the State of Louisiana (1984), promulgated by the State Health Office pursuant to La.R.S. 40:4, and, in particular, Chapter XVIII relating to jails and prisons, is the applicable regulation for determining compliance with the State Health Code. The exception to this rule is that Sections 18:007 and 18:008 do not apply to the Old Parish Prison Building.


2. Chapter 17 of the Louisiana Administrative Code and La.R.S. 40:1561-1596.5 as they reference the general powers and procedures of the Fire Marshal's Office [both printed in the Official Manual of the Louisiana Fire Marshal (1992), promulgated by the State Fire Marshal pursuant to La.R.S.40:1563(F)], are the applicable regulations for determining compliance with the State Fire Code.
