FINAL ORDERS

GERTNER, U.S.D.J.

After considering the *Plaintiffs' Assented to Motion for Final Orders*, the Court grants the motion. The Court orders the following:

1. The Court **APPROVES** the payment of \$663 to Blackman Kallick Bartelstein, LLP ("BK") for the preparation and filing of the 2005 tax return, and the Court **ORDERS** that BK be paid within 30 days from the date of this Order.


2. The Court **APPROVES** the award of the remaining balance in the Settlement Fund to Massachusetts Correctional Legal Services, Inc. (MCLS) under the *cy pres* doctrine, and the Court **ORDERS** that the award be made within 30 days from the date of this Order. The Court **further ORDERS** that any additional amount remaining after unclaimed funds are transferred to the Massachusetts Treasury pursuant to the State's Abandoned Property Act will also be awarded to MCLS within 30 days from the transfer to the Massachusetts Treasury.

3. The Court **ORDERS** that BK maintain all claim forms and other claims related documents for one year from the date of this Order. After that date, BK may destroy the documents. Exempt from this Order will be any items related to taxes including copies of the tax returns filed and 1099s returned which will be saved for the time period required by law.

4. The Court **ORDERS** that this case be closed as an active case on the court's docket, subject only to monitoring of the use of the funds given to MCLS.
