ORDER

Because of the emergency caused by the explosive increase in the jail population, this Court has formulated a contingency plan and now issues the following Orders.

The maximum available bed space in both of the detention facilities of the City of St. Louis, namely the jail and the workhouse, has been exceeded. Therefore the Court is prepared to order the transfer of certain detainees to a jail in Illinois where jail bed space will be rented by the City of St. Louis. This will be an emergency assignment for a limited time. During this interim period, the Court Orders the following:

1. No prisoner may be accepted at the City Jail or MSI on writs of habeas corpus ad prosequendum or ad testificandum.
2. All prisoners being held in the City Jail or MSI for parole violations must be removed by the State Parole Board as soon as possible, and no other parole violator may be admitted


before September 16, 1994, unless by special order of this Court.

3. If necessary, the officials of the St. Louis Department of Corrections are ORDERED to release upon special recognizance as many probation violators as necessary in order to reduce the jail population to the number of beds available in the City Jail and MSI, and under no circumstances to exceed 595 male detainees.

This Court is now attempting to effectuate a contract between the City of St. Louis and the Sheriff in charge of an Illinois jail for rental of jail cells. If this cannot be done, the Court will then have to order the utilization of jail beds elsewhere, and in particular the utilization of secure facilities in certain mental health institutions in the City of St. Louis that are not now being utilized.

On Monday, August 29, 1994, the Court will issue a memorandum and order setting forth detailed information and specific orders concerning this matter.
