ORDER

Based on the matters discussed in conference with the parties this morning;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Sheriff of the City of St. Louis is granted permission to transport fourteen additional individuals to the Macoupin County, Illinois Jail and keep them in custody there until further order from the Court.


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Sheriff of the City of St. Louis is granted permission to keep the fourteen individuals originally transported to the Macoupin County, Illinois Jail on February 3, 1995 in custody there until further order from the Court.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the City of St. Louis is granted permission to pursue discussions with Macoupin County, Illinois concerning a contract for the custody of additional pretrial detainees and probation violators at the Macoupin County Jail.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the City of St. Louis shall provide the Court with a written report regarding the conditions and capacity of the Arsenal Street facility on or before February 10, 1995.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Sheriff of the City of St. Louis shall provide the Court with a written report regarding the number of probation violators that are currently in his custody and the average length of these individuals' confinement on or before February 10, 1995.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Judges of the Twenty-Second Judicial Circuit shall provide the Court with a written report indicating how the judges are notified of alleged probation violations, how and when the judges schedule probation violation hearings, and how quickly the judges dispose of alleged probation violations, or before February 10, 1995.
