CONSENT DISMISSAL

Come now all current parties to this action and state to the Court:

1. All former prisoners of Defendant City of St. Louis, recently housed at Defendant St. Louis City's Jail facility at 124 South 14th Street, St. Louis, Missouri 63103 (the "Jail"), have been recently transferred to the St. Louis County Justice Center in Clayton, Missouri or to other appropriate facilities.
2. The Jail has been shuttered, is scheduled to be razed and there exists no current plans for its future use to house prisoners of Defendant City of St. Louis.
3. All prior alleged constitutional violations of the various jail facilities of the City of St. Louis have been remedied as of this date.

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4. The federal Prison Litigation Reform Act (18 U.S.C. § 3626 and other applicable law and court decisions make the dismissal of this cause appropriate at this time.



For the reasons above stated, all active parties to this cause believe the time is now ripe for the dismissal of this cause concerning past conditions of Defendant City of St. Louis' Jail and its Medium Security Institution (the "Workhouse") at 7600 Hall Street, St. Louis, Missouri 63147 and by the below, respective signatures of their counsel, all active parties to this case consent to and request a dismissal of this cause by the Court.

6. Counsel for Plaintiffs shall have 15 days from the entry of this Consent Dismissal to submit to the Court a final request for fees and costs, not previously sought or awarded.

7. All costs of this cause shall be taxed against Defendant City of St. Louis.


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

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
