Dear Judge Jackson:

I realize you must be very busy, with numerous responsibilities that take a great deal of your time and consideration. But under the circumstances which myself and other prisoners confined at the St. Louis City Jail face, I must ask that you consider this correspondence and enclosures with the full force of your judicial authority and take the appropriate action necessary under the law.

I am addressing this correspondence to you because I believe you have jurisdiction over the St. Louis City Jail by way of Tyler, et al. v. Murphy, et al., Cause No. 74-40-C(4). I also believe you are presiding over this case.

As you can see from the enclosure herein directed to Freeman R. Bosley Jr. and other various St. Louis City Officials and Correctional Personnel, myself and other prisoners feel our guaranteed rights under the United States Constitution are being infringed and violated by the implementation of arbitrary and capricious policy's by the St. Louis City Jail.

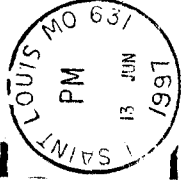

1. The M.S.I. total inmate population is
680.
2. The technical probation violation is forty-five (45)
inmates.

4. There are sixteen (16) commitments for contempt of court serving time.
5. The jail population committee can very easily verify these statistics.
