ON THE ABOVE DATE OFFICER M.C. MCKINNEY, ADVISED THE INMATES OF THE ST. LOUIS COUNTY JAIL, OF A NEW RULE ISSUED BY AARON MENSEY, DEPUTY CHIEF OF CUSTODY. THE NEW RULE STATES THAT; SHOULD ANY ONE INMATE IN AN EIGHT (8) MAN CELL VIOLATE A JAIL RULE, THE ENTIRE CELL, ALL EIGHT (8) MEN WILL BE PUNISHED. PUNISHMENT WILL BE LEFT TO THE OFFICER ON DUTY AND THERE WILL NOT BE A HEARING TO DETERMINE OR SINGLE OUT THE GUILTY PARTY. PUNISHMENT WILL CONSIST OF CELL "DEAD LOCK" THAT IS; LOSS OF VISITS, PHONE CALLS, RECREATION, COMMISSARY, NEWS PAPERS, T.V. ETC.

WE BELIEVE THIS IS IN VIOLATION OF OUR CONSTITUTIONAL RIGHT TO DUE PROCESS OF LAW.
