Dear Judge,

Earlier this year I complained to you about the poor regulation of the dangerous drug, lithium carbonate, by Doctor Lucido and Nurse, Angela Tut, of the Medical Service of the St. Louis County Department of Justice Services. Not properly regulated, this drug could cause me to suffer a toxic reaction, which could lead to death. Once a month, lithium levels are mandatory, according to Dr. Paraga of Forensic Medicine of Fulton State Hospital & Dr. A. Mallya, Coordinator of Medical Affairs, of St. Louis State Hospital Complex. Doctor Lucido orders a lithium level done on me every 4 months, a very dangerous practice, according to Dr. Paraga, Dr. Mallya and Dr. Knolls, another Psychiatrist, who is in private practice. These 3 Doctors have told me this dangerous drug should not be discontinued even for just one day. When Dr. Lucido does order a lithium level, he discontinues the lithium ^{for} 3 to 4 days, which causes me tremendous difficulties. I am eagerly awaiting Judge Bond ^{to} ~~to~~ ^{HAVE} take my deposition this month. Thank al Franco
