COMPLIANCE OF JOHN P. EMDE WITH ORDER OF DECEMBER 11, 1980

Comes now John P. Emde pursuant to, and in response to,
the Order of December 11, 1980 entered in this action and states
as follows:

1. The Order of December 11, 1980 directs the undersigned
to submit a list specifying all conditions to be remedied and
all actions to be taken in accordance with the judgment of the
Court entered in Cause No. 76-210 C (2); attached hereto, marked
Exhibit "A" is a copy of the aforesaid JUDGMENT AND ORDER entered
by the Court on or about December 30, 1977 in said action
76-210 C (3); paragraphs 1, 9, 10, and 11 of the aforesaid
JUDGMENT AND ORDER do not specify any "condition to be remedied"
or "actions to be taken" and thus said paragraphs have no direct
relevancy to the Order of December 11, 1980; paragraph 2 of the
JUDGMENT AND ORDER of December 30, 1977 requires the renovation
and reconstruction of the "cell blocks" which renovation project
was required to be completed in one year from the date of said
Order and, a recent inspection of the facilities indicates that
said renovation has been completed; paragraph 3 of the aforesaid
JUDGMENT AND ORDER relates solely to the actions to be taken by
the Director of Welfare pending completion of all of the renovation
and construction so that provisions of paragraph 3 are currently
inapplicable to the present Order.
