THIS MATTER, having been brought before the Court by Charles LaDuca, Esquire, counsel for plaintiffs, pursuant to L.Civ.R. 37.1, with respect to a discovery dispute between the parties concerning written discovery and the scheduling of depositions; and

THE COURT, having conducted a conference call concerning these disputes on October 23, 2006, with Mr. LaDuca, William Riback, Esquire and Alexandra Warren, Esquire participating on behalf of plaintiffs, and Patrick J. Madden, Esquire participating on behalf of defendants;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED this 24<sup>th</sup> day of October, 2006 AS FOLLOWS:

1. Defendants shall respond to plaintiffs' interrogatories and request for production of documents on or by November 6, 2006, with the exception of plaintiffs' discovery requests seeking booking sheets and other records and information for all pre-trial detainees charged with misdemeanors, violations, violation of parole, violation of probation, or held on civil or family court matters at the Gloucester Prison System, responses to which discovery requests shall be furnished on or by November 13, 2006.
2. Depositions shall commence after November 6, 2006.

3. The parties shall agree to a deposition schedule whereby the witnesses shall be deposed in the following order:

- a. class representative;
- b. Defendants' 30(b)(6) designee;
- c. second class representative; and
- d. the Warden of the Gloucester County Department of Corrections.
