THIS MATTER, having been brought before the Court by Patrick J. Madden, Esquire, counsel for the Defendants, pursuant to L.Civ.R. 37.1 with respect to a dispute between the parties concerning discovery of the medical and mental treatment of the Plaintiff Sandra K. Wilson; and

THE COURT, having conducted a conference call concerning these disputes on December 7, 2006, with Charles LaDuca, Esquire, Alexandra Warren, Esquire and William Riback, Esquire participating on behalf of Plaintiffs and Patrick J. Madden, Esquire participating on behalf of Defendants; and

THE COURT, having considered the arguments of counsel and for further good cause having been shown,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED ^{22nd} this day of December, 2006, as follows:

1. Defendants' application seeking the identity of Plaintiff's health care providers for the ten years past is denied as overbroad.
2. Defendants are entitled to Plaintiff's records of treatment and counseling by The South Jersey Behavioral Health Resources PACE Program.
3. Defendants are entitled to documents and information related to any mental health treatment or counseling from the time period of December 7, 2001 to the present date.
4. Defendants are entitled to production of documents and information pertaining to Plaintiff's receipt of drug, narcotic or "controlled dangerous substance" treatment and/or counseling from September 1, 2003 to the present date.
5. A copy of this Order may be served upon any health care provider, person or entity maintaining records as set forth above, together with a subpoena demanding the production of same.
