Subject : SUPPLEMENT TO SECTION A-3 OF THE IMPLEMENTATION PLAN TO
THE CONSENT DECREE


Due to the fact that the population of the LVMPD Detention facilities has not been reduced sufficiently enough to implement the classification plan as outlined in Section A-3 of that document, it has become necessary to re-evaluate present conditions and develop a new classification system.

Extensive use was made of the Court-approved Jefferson County, Alabama, and Lucas County, Ohio, classification plans in developing this system.

Prior to the implementation of this plan, two employees of the LVMPD Detention facility will be traveling to the National Institute of Corrections in Boulder, Colorado, to receive training in classifying inmates. This seminar will take place from November 4 through 9, 1979. Implementation will then take place within 45 days of their return.

Copies of the two applications to the Institute naming the employees to attend, along with a letter from Mr. Gary M. Bowker who is the program specialist for the National Institute of Corrections, stating the probability of their acceptance, are attached.

The re-modeling of the Rehabilitation Farm is projected to be completed in March of 1980. Completion of this facility will enable this Department to expand and improve the attached classification procedure.
