By letter dated April 4, 2007, counsel for the plaintiffs in the above captioned case requested leave of Court for an Order directing the Schenectady County Department of Social Services to provide last known addresses for all persons for whom the previously produced booking record addresses proved to be inaccurate.

Having considered plaintiffs' counsel's letter and defendants' response, it is hereby

ORDERED that:

1. The Schenectady County Department of Social Services shall provide the last known addresses in its possession for all persons for whom the parties agree the booking records previously produced are inaccurate;


2. Plaintiffs will provide defendants a list of all those persons for whom they believe the previously produced booking records are inaccurate within seven (7) days of this Order and, if not rejected by defendants within seven (7) days thereafter, will be considered accurate and

immediately forwarded by defense counsel to the Schenectady County Department of Social Services;

3. Consistent with the parties' July 31, 2006 settlement agreement, plaintiffs' Settlement Administrator shall pay the reasonable hourly rate for all Schenectady County staff required to produce the agreed upon last known addresses, the disclosure of the last known addresses shall be limited to Class Counsel and the Settlement Administrator and used solely for effecting notice to those class members of the preliminary settlement of this case, and the record of these last known addresses will be returned to defendants or destroyed, with the consent of the defendants, within sixty (60) days after the Court grants final approval or when any appeals are exhausted, whichever date is later.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
