Plaintiffs request that the defendant Board of
Commissioners of State Institutions answer under oath in
accordance with Rule 33 of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure
the following interrogatories:

1. State the names of all Negro personnel who
supervise, service or teach only Negro youths at the following
schools:

- (a) Florida School for Boys, located at
Okeechobee, Florida.

(b) Florida School for Boys, located at
Marianna, Florida.

2. State the names of all white personnel who supervise, service or teach only white youths at the following schools:

(a) Florida School for Boys, located at
Okeechobee, Florida.

(b) Florida School for Boys, located at
Marianna, Florida.

3. State the names of all personnel who supervise, service or teach both Negro and white youths at the following schools:

(a) Florida School for Boys, located at
Okeechobee, Florida.

(b) Florida School for Boys, located at
Marianna, Florida.

4. State the names of all Negro personnel who supervise, service or teach only Negro girls at the following schools:

(a) Florida School for Girls, located at
Ocala, Florida.

(b) Florida School for Girls, located at
Forest Hills, Florida.

5. State the names of all white personnel who supervise, service or teach only white girls at the following schools:

(a) Florida School for Girls, located at Ocala,
Florida.

- (b) Florida School for Girls, located at Forest Hills, Florida.

6. State the names of all personnel who supervise, service or teach both Negro and white girls at the following schools:

- (a) Florida School for Girls, located at Ocala, Florida.
- (b) Florida School for Girls, located at Forest Hills, Florida.

7. For each housing unit on the north campus of the Florida Schools for Boys, located at Okeechobee, Florida, state:

- (a) The total number of Negro boys.
- (b) The total number of white boys.
- (c) The planned capacity of the housing unit.
- (d) Name and race of persons who serve as house parents or matrons.

8. For each housing unit on the south campus of the Florida School for Boys, located at Okeechobee, Florida, please give the information requested in Interrogatory No. 7.

9. State whether the following schools have ever maintained a policy of housing Negro and white residents separately:

- (a) The Florida School for Boys, located at Marianna, Florida.
- (b) The Florida School for Boys, located at Okeechobee, Florida.

(c) The Florida School for Girls, located at Ocala, Florida.

(d) The Florida School for Girls, located at Forest Hills, Florida.

10. If the answer to Interrogatory No. 9 is "yes," state at which schools the policy of housing Negroes and whites separately still exists.

11. State whether defendants are presently maintaining a policy of residential segregation for the schools designated by Interrogatory No. 9. If not, specify all changes defendants have made, indicating the school, the section of the campus (north or south) and the date of each change.

12. For the following schools, please state the courses offered and the total enrollment of students for each course by race:

(a) Florida School for Boys, located at Marianna, Florida.

(b) Florida School for Boys, located at Okeechobee, Florida.

(c) Florida School for Girls, located at Ocala, Florida.

(d) Florida School for Girls, located at Forest Hills, Florida.

13. Describe all recreational activities that are conducted on a racially separate basis at the following schools:

(a) Florida School for Boys, located at Marianna, Florida.

- (b) Florida School for Boys, located at Okeechobee, Florida.
- (c) Florida School for Girls, located at Ocala, Florida.
- (d) Florida School for Girls, located at Forest Hills, Florida.

14. For the following schools, describe all work crews or training programs:

- (a) Florida School for Boys, located at Marianna, Florida.
- (b) Florida School for Boys, located at Okeechobee, Florida.
- (c) Florida Schools for Girls, located at Ocala, Florida.
- (d) Florida School for Girls, located at Forest Hills, Florida.

15. For each work crew or training program, please state as of September 12, 1966; July 12, 1966; May 12, 1966; and April 12, 1966, the following:

- (a) Total number of Negroes.
- (b) Total number of whites.
- (c) Name and race of supervisor in charge.

16. If corporal punishment is inflicted for infractions of rules or regulations, state with regard to the past 60 days the following:


- (a) The names of students corporally punished.
- (b) The race of such students.
- (c) The school attended by such students.

(d) The number of strokes received.

17. For each person employed in the Central or Administrative offices of the Division of Child Training, please state the following:

- (a) Name.
