2. For the persons inquired about in Interrogatory No. 1, state whether they work at the North Campus or the South Campus at Florida School For Boys at Marianna and Okeechobee.

3. State the names of all Negro personnel who supervise, service or teach only Negro students at the following schools:

- (a) Florida School For Boys located at Okeechobee, Florida.
- (b) Florida School For Boys located at Marianna, Florida.
- (c) Florida School For Girls located at Ocala, Florida.




