ORDER

Considering the foregoing Joint Motion to Dismiss this matter and Relinquish Jurisdiction over the Conditions of Confinement Consent Decree ("Consent Decree") entered herein on February 12, 2010 (Rec. Docs. No. 286 & 241), as modified by this Court's Orders dated March 23, 2011, February 9, 2012, and November 13, 2012, (Rec. Docs. No. 252, 268, & 276),

IT IS ORDERED that the Joint Motion to Dismiss and Relinquish Jurisdiction (Rec. Doc. No. 286) is **GRANTED in part to dismiss the case without prejudice**, subject however to retaining jurisdiction in the event that the new juvenile detention facility is not completed and in operation by **April 1, 2014 upon timely motion of any party as set forth below; and**

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Consent Decree issued herein, as modified and amended, is hereby **DISSOLVED**, without prejudice to Plaintiff's right to file a motion for reinstatement of same **no later than April 1, 2014**, upon showing good cause, i.e., non-completion and non-operation of new facility by the latter date.

Jurisdiction is retained for a reasonable period to hear and

resolve timely motions to reopen case and/or reinstate Consent Decree in accordance with above directives.
