ORDER

Considering the foregoing Joint Motion to Dismiss and Relinquish Jurisdiction over the Conditions of Education Consent Decree ("Consent Decree") entered herein (Rec. Docs. No. 302 & 242),

IT IS ORDERED that the Joint Motion to Dismiss and Relinquish Jurisdiction (Rec. Doc. No. 302) is **GRANTED in part**, and the above-captioned litigation is hereby **DISMISSED without prejudice**, conditioned upon implementation of recommendations made by the Education Monitor (see Rec. Doc. 301) and with reservation of jurisdiction for court review and Defendants' compliance with good faith implementation of those recommendations within a reasonable period of time. **No later than February 14, 2014**, parties shall submit a joint report on compliance efforts with each directive and, if good cause is shown, file a motion to dissolve the consent decree.

Jurisdiction is retained for a reasonable period to hear and resolve timely motions to reopen case and/or reinstate Consent Decree in accordance with above directives.
