1. The trial of this matter shall be bifurcated into an initial trial on the issue of the adequacy of the special education program at the King County Detention Facility ("KCDF") with a second phase to follow, if necessary, on the issue of the responsibility for any funding inadequacies in the school program at KCDF.
