**ORDER DIRECTING DECLASSIFICATION OF REDACTED
MEMORANDUM OPINION AND PRIMARY ORDER**

On June 19, 2014, Judge James B. Zagel of this Court requested that the Memorandum Opinion and Primary Order issued in this docket be published pursuant to Rule 62 of the United States Foreign Intelligence Surveillance Court Rules of Procedure. The Government's declassification review of these documents is now complete, and the Court has determined that the documents, with the Government's proposed redactions, are suitable for publication.


Accordingly, it is HEREBY ORDERED that:

(1) No later than June 26, 2014, the Government shall prepare and submit to the Court formally declassified versions of the June 19, 2014, Memorandum Opinion and Primary Order that have been redacted in conformance with the Government's proposal; and

(2) Upon verifying that the versions of the June 19, 2014, Memorandum Opinion and Primary Order submitted in response to paragraph (1) above conform with the Government's proposal, the Clerk of the Court shall promptly cause those documents, as well as a copy of this

Order, to be published on the FISC's public website.
