STIPULATION OF DISMISSAL WITH PREJUDICE

For the first time in support of its Motion for Summary Judgment, Defendant U.S. Department of Justice stated, “[A]s is typical in proceedings before the FISC, no hearings were held with respect to the acknowledged Carter Page FISA applications, and thus no responsive transcripts exist.” Memorandum of Points and Authorities in Support of Defendant’s Motion for Summary Judgment at 10. In light of this information, Plaintiff Judicial Watch, Inc. no longer challenges the adequacy of Defendant’s search.
