ORDER OF BIFURCATION

- a. The Official-Capacity Defendants:
 - 1. Robert S. Mueller, the Director of the FBI;
 - 2. David V. Aguilar, Deputy Commissioner and Acting Commissioner of the CBP; and
 - 3. Janet Napolitano, Secretary of the DHS.
- b. The Individual-Capacity Defendants:
 - 1. Robert B. Thompson, an agent employed by the FBI;
 - 2. Jeff Sokolowski, an agent employed by the FBI; and
 - 3. Unidentified FBI and CBP agents.

For the reasons stated on the ecord at a hearing on May 29, 2013, pursuant to Fed.

captioned "Second Amended Complaint (Offici al-Capacity Defendants)" and a second

amended complaint against the Individual -Capacity Defendants c aptioned "Second

Amended Complaint (Individual-Capacity Def endants)." Further pleadings and papers

relating to the separate set of defendants shall be so captioned.
