JOINT STATUS REPORT

Pursuant to the Court’s January 11, 2018 order (“Order”), plaintiffs American Civil Liberties Union of Virginia, American Civil Liberties Union of Maryland, American Civil Liberties Union of Pennsylvania, and American Civil Liberties Union of Delaware, and defendants U.S. Department of Homeland Security and U.S. Customs and Border Protection (“the agency”) hereby advise the Court as follows regarding the agency’s progress in processing plaintiffs’ FOIA request:

1. The agency represents that between the date of the Court’s Order and February 28, 2018, the agency has completed processing 914 pages of potentially responsive email messages and attachments, as well as 8 spreadsheets, from the files of custodians in the Baltimore Field Office.

2. The agency further represents that in four interim responses sent to plaintiffs on

January 16, January 19, February 27, and February 28, 2018, the agency has produced to plaintiffs 914 pages of responsive email messages and attachments from the files of custodians in the Baltimore Field Office.
