

Expected Testimony of Mrs. Ernestine Hammock

I was employed as a waitress in the Continental Restaurant at the Trailways Bus Terminal for several weeks in the summer of 1962. In August, 1962 I observed a negro boy come in and order a coke. I gave him a glass of water and started to get the coke when a uniformed Shreveport Police Officer escorted the negro out of the restaurant. This officer then returned and told me not to wait on colored people in the restaurant or he would put me in jail.
