Dear Mr. Curtis:

On August 2, 1962, in accordance with Judge Hunter's direction that opposing counsel furnish each other a list of witnesses and summary of testimony expected to be produced upon the hearing, I sent you and defense counsel such a list and summary. Since that time we have acquired further information relating to the case and our list of possible witnesses has increased. Accordingly, I am now enclosing a new list and summary which includes the material which I sent on August 2 as well as new evidence which we expect to produce at the hearing on November 2nd.

With the exception of Harold Bledsoe, whom we expect to call as a witness on November 2, the list does not include the names and a summary of the testimony of those witnesses whose depositions were taken. We shall, however, offer the depositions in evidence under the pre-trial stipulation that they could be so considered.
