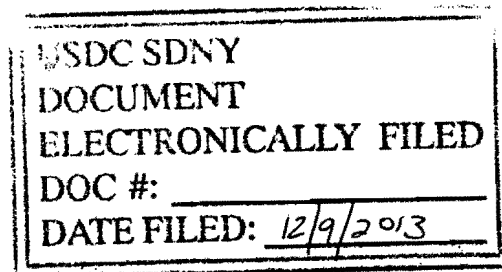

ORDER**



The Court having held a status conference on November 19, 2013, at 4:30 p.m., and the parties thereafter having submitted an agreement as to the following matters, it is hereby ORDERED that:


1. In light of the parties' continued efforts to reach a complete resolution of this matter, Plaintiffs' motion for preliminary injunctive relief is hereby dismissed without prejudice to its renewal.
2. The parties shall continue to meet and confer on a regular basis to discuss a potential resolution of this action.
3. By January 20, 2014 and March 20, 2014, the parties shall submit a joint letter to the Court advising on the progress of their negotiations.
4. By May 20, 2014, if no resolution is reached, the parties shall submit a proposed Rule 16(d) Scheduling Order to the Court setting a schedule for all pretrial matters, including a date by which Plaintiffs shall renew their motion

for preliminary injunctive relief, a briefing schedule on that motion, dates for fact and expert discovery, and a proposed date for a preliminary injunction hearing.

5. If the parties reach an impasse in their settlement negotiations at any time before May 20, 2014, Plaintiffs may notify the Court by letter, and renew Plaintiffs' motion for preliminary injunctive relief.
