Upon consideration of the verified complaint presented to the Court in these cases by inmate Janice Phillips, presently confined by the State of Alabama in Tutwiler Prison, wherein it appears that Janice Phillips is possibly suffering from a medical condition of an emergency nature and is being deprived of an examination by medical specialists and treatment, if indicated, by medical specialists, it is the ORDER, JUDGMENT and DECREE of this Court that the defendants Judson C. Locke, Jr., as Commissioner of the Alabama Board of Corrections, and Doris Wood, Warden of Tutwiler Prison, forthwith schedule with a medical specialist in the field of gynecology and/or internal medicine a complete physical examination for the said Janice Phillips and transport the said Janice Phillips to the designated location for said examination and appropriate treatment.

It is further ORDERED that the examining physician or physicians file a written report with this Court as to their diagnosis, prognosis and recommended treatment.
