2. Counsel shall inform all such persons who receive or review the aforesaid documents that they are bound by the terms of this Order.

3. Such documents, information or materials may be presented for any use under the Federal Rules of Civil



Procedure, or presented as evidence at any trial or hearing of the captioned case, subject to any privilege that may be asserted by PHS.

4. Nothing contained herein shall be construed as an admission that any prior request for discovery, formal or informal, is reasonable or necessary. Entry of this Order does not prevent plaintiffs from applying to the Court at a later date for relief from this Order, nor does it prevent any party or PHS from moving for further protective orders as may be deemed appropriate.


