Plaintiff has filed a class action complaint at docket 31. The filing appears to be timely. See the order at docket 30. Whether the court will actually certify a class, and if so, the definition of the class are issues yet to be determined. However, it is clear that there is a good possibility that a class will be certified. The district judge presently assigned to this case is a visiting judge who does not have chambers in Arizona. Were the case to be certified as a class action, it would be much more effectively managed by a judge who has chambers and immediate access to a courtroom in Arizona. The question of certification should be decided by the same judge who would handle the case in the event a class were to be certified. For these reasons, the assigned judge directs the Clerk of Court to re-assign this case to a district judge who has chambers in Arizona.
