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

Plaintiffs and defendants hereby agree that the following stipulations may be incorporated into a remedial order to be issued, subject to Court approval, in this case. By entering into these stipulations, however, defendants do not concede that anyone of the individual measures or actions described herein is required by the federal or state constitutions. Moreover, the procedures set forth in the "Preliminary Statement" to the "Stipulations Regarding Remedy," a copy of which is attached to plaintiffs brief on remand (filed on or about August 17, 1981), are incorporated herein by reference.

Accordingly, plaintiffs and defendants stipulate as follows:

1. Cellhouse 3 at the Colorado Territorial Correctional Facility may be used to house medium and minimum security prisoners provided that:


(a) the building or buildings comprising Cellhouse 3 are remodeled and repaired as set forth in the Project Manual for "Project No. 20481/2772 Colorado," prepared by Holding Associates and entitled "Cell House 3 Repairs, Territorial Facility, Canon City, Colorado (July, 1981)" (Exhibit A hereto);

(b) the correctional program for prisoners confined in Cellhouse 3 at Colorado Territorial Correctional Facility shall be generally as set forth in the document entitled "Program Plan; Repair of Cell House # 3," Territorial Correctional Facility, Canon City, Colorado, prepared by the Colorado Department of Corrections and Holding Associates (June, 1981) (Exhibit B hereto); and



(c) subsequent to the remodeling and repair of Cellhouse 3, space in the basement of that facility will be made available for additional program space or day room area, including without limitation a hobby shop.

2. The stipulations previously reached between the parties, as approved by the Court and set forth in the order dated August 26, 1981, shall apply to Cellhouse 3.



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
