PARTIES' SUPPLEMENTAL AGREED PLAN FOR IMPLEMENTATION  
OF THE COURT'S JUNE 30, 1989 ORDER

The parties submit this document as a supplement to their agreed plan filed December 19, 1990. There remain several proposals about which the parties could not agree. Defendants are submitting their objections to these proposals on this date. The plaintiffs will respond to these objections within ten days.

A. ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH

1. Defendants shall provide prisoners with 20 foot candles of light in the living areas, including prisoners in the lower bunks of double bunks.

2. Defendants shall develop a plan by April 1, 1990 for assuring that sleepers are protected from unnecessary risks of contracting airborne disease.

B. FIRE SAFETY

1. Defendants shall develop a plan by April 1, 1990, to implement paragraphs 8 b. 2; c. 2; d; g; and h of plaintiffs' fire


2. Defendants shall develop a plan by April 1, 1990 for the creation of an emergency power source activated when any living area is without power and to which the smoke detectors and alarm systems are connected.

C. HEALTH CARE

Defendants shall provide adequate and sufficient staff, trained in identification of mental health problems, to interview each prisoner at intake to determine appropriateness of the facility assignment.



