STIPULATION ON MENTAL HEALTH COMPLIANCE

Parties have met with the Special Officer, Grace Lopes, pursuant to the order by this Court dated July 1, 1993. The parties have discussed the delivery of mental health services to seriously mentally ill residents at the Occoquan Facility and have stipulated to the following with respect to the delivery of mental health services to this population.

1. Once a month, beginning in March, 1994 and continuing for a total of twelve months, defendants agree to submit to the plaintiffs and the Special Officer a report (hereinafter "Monthly Compliance Report on the Delivery of Mental Health Services to Seriously Mentally Ill Occoquan Prisoners") which summarizes particular features of their delivery of mental health services to seriously mentally ill Occoquan prisoners. This report will be submitted on or after the fifth day of the month following the month being reported on.

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2. Defendants agree to include the following information in the monthly report:
  - a. The name and DOC number of each Occoquan prisoner who is currently on psychotropic medications.
  - b. The log (or summary) of prisoners by name and DOC number, placed in the Adjustment Unit (formerly called Q Block) for mental observation during the prior thirty-day period. It will contain the dates and times of entry and release from the Adjustment Unit.
  - c. The date of actual transfer of an Occoquan prisoner to another facility for mental health observation or treatment during the prior thirty-day period. The prisoner will be identified by name and DOC number and the facility to which he is transferred will be identified; the dates should correspond to each separate transfer which has occurred during the prior thirty day period.
3. The defendants agree to produce this report monthly beginning thirty days after this Stipulation is signed and to transmit the report to Special Officer, Grace Lopes and to plaintiffs' counsel Stuart H. Adams, Jr., beginning thirty days after this Stipulation is signed.


4. Plaintiffs agree to maintain the confidentiality of the prisoner medical information contained within the report.
  
5. Defendants agree to certify, to the best of their knowledge and belief upon reasonable inquiry, all statements in the Monthly Compliance Report on the Delivery of Mental Health Services to Seriously Mentally Ill Occoquan Prisoners are true and accurate.


