PLAINTIFFS' MOTION FOR CONTEMPT AND TO ENFORCE
THE COURT'S ORDER FOR INJUNCTIVE RELIEF

Plaintiffs, the women prisoners of the District of Columbia, bring this motion to enforce the Court's Order for Declaratory and Injunctive Relief (Rev. Order 6/16/97). Defendants have been under order to remedy constitutional violations since December 1994, but to date, many remedies have still not been implemented in the areas of sexual misconduct, environmental and fire safety at the Correctional Treatment Facility (CTF), and programs at CTF. Thus, plaintiffs seek relief from this Court to enforce the relief previously imposed.

For the reasons set forth in the accompanying memorandum in support of this motion, plaintiffs request that the Court enter the attached order finding the defendants in violation of the Order for Declaratory and Injunctive Relief. In addition, plaintiffs seek relief in the form of prospective fines, a court-appointed expert, and attorneys' fees for the

defendants' failure to abide by the Court's Order.


