**ORDER**

This case is before the Court on plaintiff Kelvin Frazier's *pro se* Motion for Preliminary Injunction (Doc. 150) and accompanying declaration (Doc. 151). Pursuant to Local Rule 2.03(d), a party represented by counsel is not permitted to submit pleadings *pro se*. Here, Mr. Frazier is represented by multiple lawyers who, according to Mr. Frazier, are aware of the allegations contained in his motion and declaration, and the Court will therefore **deny** the motion without prejudice to refile by counsel if deemed appropriate. However, given the serious nature of the allegations contained in the motion and accompanying declaration, the Court directs counsel for defendants to forthwith deliver a copy of this Order and Mr. Frazier's motion and accompanying declaration to the warden of Santa Rosa Correctional Institute to ensure that he is aware of the allegations and conducts any appropriate investigation. The Clerk is also instructed to send a copy of this Order directly to plaintiff Kelvin Frazier.
