STIPULATION OF THE PARTIES

Under the consent decree approved by this Court on June 12, 1985, each of the three panels of experts provided for pursuant to ¶I(E) of the decree includes one representative of the Corrections Division. The parties hereby agree that ¶I(G) of the decree shall be modified in so far as the role of the respective

Corrections Division representatives shall henceforth be limited. Such representatives shall not participate in the semi-annual inspections and in the preparation of the inspection reports indicating the defendants' compliance with the provisions of the respective implementation plans. However, the respective Corrections Division representatives designated to serve on each panel shall continue to participate in any planning role required of the respective panels under the decree.
