This case has been opened for the administrative convenience of the court, incorporating two cases for which the court records are not accessible electronically: Remmers v. Brewer, 4:72-cv-177 and Wycoff v. Scurr, 4:81-cv-303. On December 16, 2004 defendants filed a [Rule] 60(b) Motion seeking relief from injunctions entered in these two cases in 1973 and 1986 (modified in 1987), respectively. Both cases involved the Church of the New Song (CONS).


During the original proceedings in these cases, plaintiffs were represented by counsel. On its own motion and upon consideration of the factors in Edgington v. Missouri Dep't of Corrections, 52 F.3d 777, 780 (8th Cir. 1995), the Court appoints Patrick Ingram to represent plaintiffs in this case.

Counsel will note that the original plaintiffs and original defendants have been named in this case. Many years have passed and those individuals may or may not continue to be involved or have an interest in these proceedings. Additionally, the 60(b)

motion may require review of extensive records from the original, or related proceedings before the issues are joined. This matter is set for a R. 16(b) telephone conference call with the undersigned **beginning at 9:00 a.m. on Friday, February 18, 2005** to discuss these issues and scheduling of these proceedings. The Court will place the call.
