MEMORANDUM ORDER

SHADUR, District Judge.

*1 This Court has received and reviewed (1) the November 30, 1988 draft Proposed Remedial Plan prepared by Special Master Norval Morris, (2) the December 15, 1988 responsive letter and enclosure from plaintiffs' counsel to Special Master Morris and (3) the December 16 responsive letter and enclosure from defendants' counsel to Special Master Morris. As all parties are aware, this matter is currently scheduled for a status hearing December 30, 1988. In light of the scope and extent of the parties' responsive suggestions, it appears to this Court that the following timetable is appropriate (unless Special Master Morris finds the first

step unattainable):

1. Special Master Morris is directed to submit his Proposed Remedial Order to this Court,¹ with copies also to be served on the parties, on or before December 21, 1988.
2. Counsel for the parties shall file with this Court their comments on Special Master Morris' submission, with copies also to be served on the opposing counsel and Special Master Morris, on or before December 28, 1988.

If Special Master Morris cannot meet the December 21 schedule, a modification of the timetable will be established by further court order.

This Court has also reviewed and hereby approves the expenses incurred in connection with (1) the services performed by Special Master Morris and persons authorized to assist him in the Special Mastership and (2) the purchase of related equipment,² all as detailed on the statements attached as Exhibits 1, 2 and 3. Accordingly the Clerk of Court is authorized and directed to issue, out of the funds on deposit in this case, a check in the sum of \$16,912.02 payable to the "Special Master Norval Morris Special Account," to enable Special Master Morris to make payment to the following payees as reflected on the attached Exhibits:
